

Where does the “dues not belonging to unit” go? Here is the breakdown, which can be found in the bylaws:

#### Article IV – Membership and Dues

##### Section 4.

Each member of the association shall pay annual dues of    \*\*    dollars (\$      ) per member (also means per capita) to the association.

**\*\* This amount is specific to the individual PTA. It should be greater than or equal to the amount that is forwarded to North Coastal Council (\$5.60).**

- a. Such annual dues shall include the portion of two dollars and twenty-five cents (\$2.25) per member payable to the National PTA.
- b. Such annual dues shall include the portion of two dollars (\$2.00) per member payable to the California State PTA.
- c. Such annual dues shall include the portion of one dollar (\$1.00) per member payable to Ninth District PTA.
- d. Such annual dues shall include the portion of thirty-five cents (\$0.35) per member payable to North Coastal Council of PTAs.
- e. Each association shall forward to the council per capita dues of five dollars and sixty cents (\$5.60) annually.
- f. The remainder shall constitute the local portion of each member’s dues and shall remain in the association.
